Driving on concrete too soon can result in tire marks imprinting in your driveway. It's an aesthetic issue, but there is also a risk of the weight of your vehicle displacing enough concrete to create an uneven surface or even cracking the concrete slab.

While the exact curing time can vary depending on factors such as mix design, weather conditions, and thickness, it is essential to follow the general guidelines of waiting at least 24 to 48 hours for pedestrian traffic and 7 days for personal vehicles. For heavy vehicles, such as delivery trucks or construction machinery, it is recommended to wait for an extended period. Typically, waiting for 28 days or longer is advised, as this allows the concrete to achieve maximum strength and durability necessary to bear heavy loads.

WBUD's policies and specifications state that WBUD must install the STEP system before any permanent work is done, i.e. Driveway.

The property owner signing this document hereby certifies that he or she is authorized to permit Watts Bar Utility District (WBUD) and / or its contractors or subcontractors to enter the property whose address appears below to deliver the STEP system materials.

In connection with Watts Bar Utility District (WBUD) and / or its contractors or subcontractors' delivery and install of the materials and presence on the property, you hereby release Watts Bar Utility District (WBUD) and / or its contractors or subcontractors from any liability for damages to the driveways, sidewalks, curbs, walkways.

This release shall bind all parties who are in any way responsible for the condition of the property or construction activities thereon, including without limitation, any owner, occupant or tenant of the property.
